What is a Continuum of Care (CoC)?

- Required by HUD starting in 1995 single application for McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Grants
- Intent encourage coordination of housing and services at local level; more structural and strategic approach
- 1. A system of programs, resources, services, and data
- 2. A coalition structure and process
- 3. A HUD (and more) funding program
- CoC transition Homeless Action Partnership (HAP) to Housing for Health Partnership (H4HP) – Housing for a Healthy Santa Cruz Framework – June 2021 new governance charter
